Please keep a look out on the notice board for when activities are taking place with Jemma.



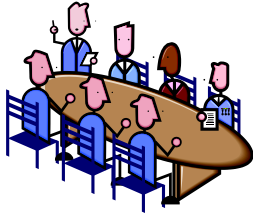
Comment Cards

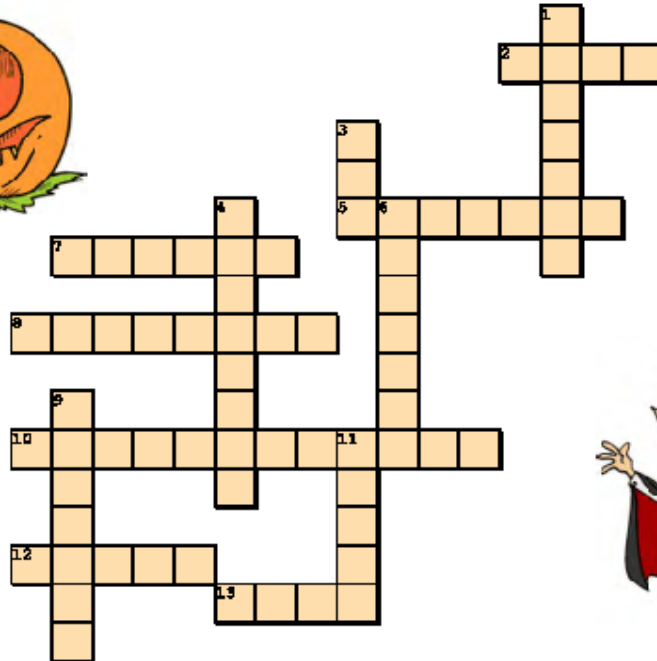
