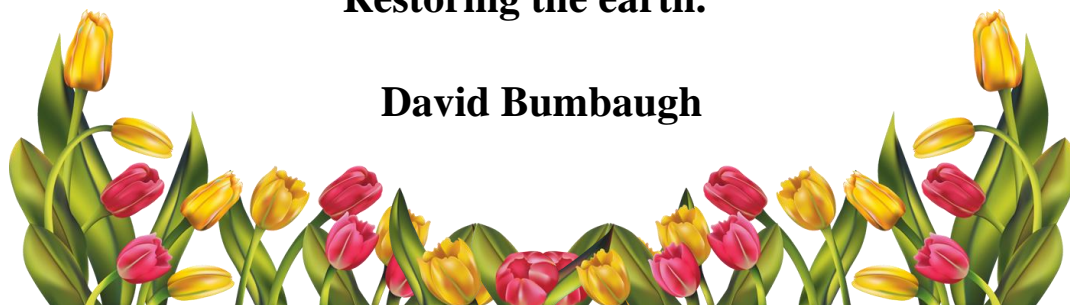

**We would also like to send a big thank you to everyone who has sent in lovely well wishes and thanks, it is greatly appreciated.**



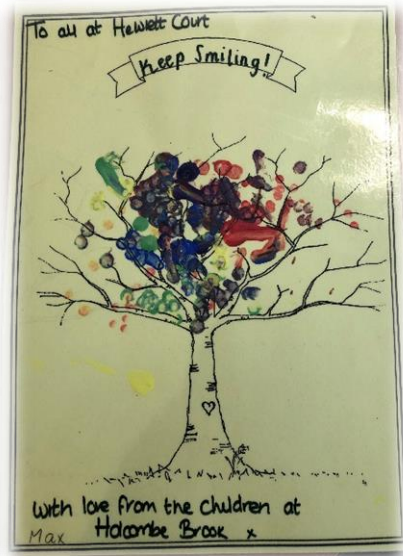
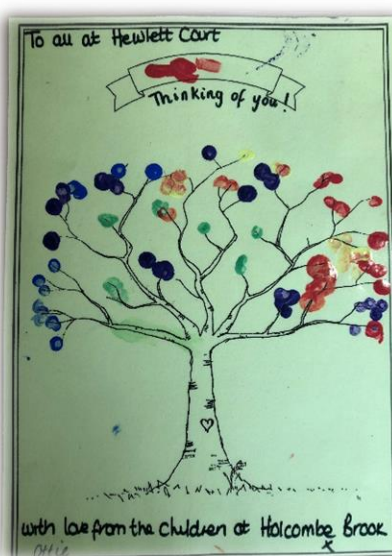
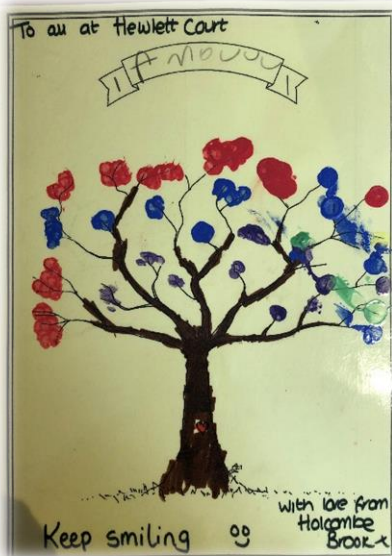

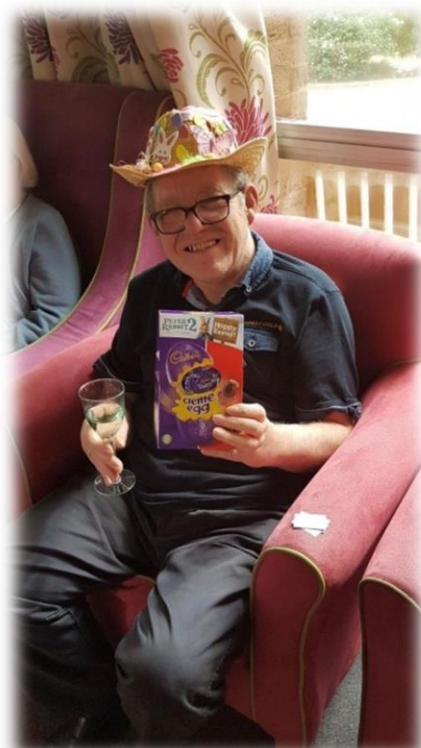
## Happy Easter!

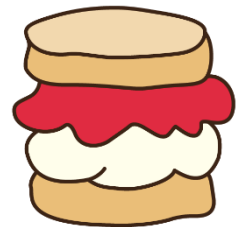
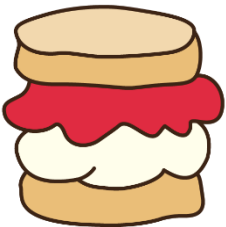
